2) UPDATE ON AND REQUEST FOR RECOMMENDATIONS ON PROPOSED PLACEMENT OF ELEMENTS AT LA CIENEGA PARK AND RECREATION COMPLEX

Community Services Director Nancy Hunt Coffey provided background: At the December 18, 2018 City Council meeting, the City Council discussed the pros and cons of consolidating the buildings on the west side of La Cienega Boulevard versus maintaining buildings on both sides of the street. The City Council directed staff and the architect team to return to the various sport organizations to gather feedback on which options they would prefer. Focus groups were held with sports field users, representatives from aquatics and tennis. After much discussion, three (3) options emerged as possibilities.

The architect team of Johnson Favaro presented these options in addition to a 3D model for a building that could accommodate all of the needs expressed by both the Community and City Council.

All agreed to move forward with this master plan and present to City Council.
