2) Review of Agreement with MV Transportation for Operation and Maintenance of the City's Transit Services

Transportation Planner Martha Eros introduced the background information for the upcoming City Council presentation regarding the review of the agreement with MV Transportation for operation and maintenance of the City's Transit Services. City Staff is recommending the approval of the contract with MV Transportation for the Senior Dial-A-Ride Shuttle service for a seven year agreement, plus three one-year extensions.

Topics and questions voiced by the group included the following:

- Costs for Dial-A-Ride, Trolley operation, and special charters
- Possibility of looking into electric or hybrid vehicles
- Options for leased versus purchases vehicles

Mayor Gold recommended that the service be phone-based, not solely app based, and requested that staff look at leased vehicle option costs. Councilmember Friedman requested further evaluation of the Trolley, and taxi/coupon on demand options.
